

SNAPSHOT – Special Operation – Port-au-Prince- Miragoane-Les Cayes

Due to a severe lack of fuel in the affected department of South of Haiti and little humanitarian cargo received so far, several partners had requested the support of the LogCluster to conduct a special operation between Oct 10th and Oct 12th.

In total, the cargo has been combined for 11 different agencies (Food, Logistics Supplies, WASH items, Health and NFIs).



The operation has been held using maritime transport up to Miragoane combined with a road convoy up to Les Cayes.



The LogCluster coordinated the set up of the operation, conducted the assessment of Miragoane port and the support from the different partners involved.

A very efficient collaboration was provided by the partners, allowing the success of the operation.



WFP Logistics provided the ship and related services, **OXFAM GB** took charge of the offloading of the vessel, **CRS** provided the trucks for the inter-agency convoy and **Terre des Hommes** coordinated the efforts in Les Cayes.



With the facilitation of the people on the ground, the landing craft beached next to a private pier in Miragoane.

Oxfam organised the offloading at Miragoane into the CRS trucks. The convoy stayed overnight at the MINUSTAH base and the next morning has been escorted until Les Cayes.

At Minustah base in Les Cayes, Terre des Hommes checked that each partner picked up their cargo on time.
