Darfur

North Darfur- No changes since last report

► Background

IDP movements were set off by fighting around Mau in mid-October.

► Background

As a result of ongoing fighting in the area, households were displaced from Burm Burm and Kohr-Gubah villages (NE of Karamje).

Additionally, new IDP arrivals, displaced due to conflict in Negeha during late December, have been reported in Jakhara.

WEST DARFUR

► Background

Conflict around Kutrum and Quila has displaced populations to Nertiti North Camp. Additionally, on 25 January, 151 households were reported to have arrived in Um Dukkhun following conflict in eastern Chad.

Also, populations were displaced to Hassa-Hissa in Zalingei due to conflict in the Jebel Mara area.

CENTRAL EQUATORIA – No changes since last report

Populations formerly displaced from Gemeiza to Terekeka have been reported as returning to their areas of origin.

JONGLEI

► Background

On 19 September, inter-tribal conflict in Duk Padiet caused displacements. As Sector Lead, UNJLC will continue to monitor, update partners and coordinate NFI assistance as required.

On 31 December, in Atar, possible displacements were reported due to inter-tribal conflict.

Additionally, clashes mid-January in Kolanyang (border area between Canal and Fangak counties) were reported to have large-scale displacement to Phom el Zeraf in Fangak County.

LAKES

► Background

Inter-tribal fighting was reported on 16 November in Kalthok Village, Puluk Payam, Awerial County; an inter-agency rapid assessment will be planned when the security situation improves. Populations were scattered, including to Pariak, Jonglei (*see Jonglei for further details*).

Conflict was reported in Akot, Rumbek East County, in early January, affecting 12 villages.

Additionally cross border cattle raids were reported between Lakes and Unity States in November with last reported attack on 24 December, resulting in displacements to Maper, Tonj East County.
