Response to New Displacements

Darfur

► **Background**

Conflict in February in the vicinities of Muhajiria, Sheria and Labado in South Darfur created displacements to various areas of North Darfur, including Zamzam camp. In mid-May an additional caseload of 312 households arrived in Zamzam camp, fearing the outbreak of conflict in Dar es Salam. As NFI & ES Sector Lead, UNJLC is coordinating Sector support for all newly-displaced households as required.

CENTRAL EQUATORIA

► **Background**

Inter-tribal clashes in late April and May displaced between 800-1,200 IDPs to Munuki Payam according to an inter-agency assessment in May.

JONGLEI- No changes from the last report

► **Background**

Conflict in March and April in Nyandit and Kuechar Payams displaced a total of 3,536 households to Akobo Town. Additional fighting in Le-Kuangole Payam in March displaced 6,000 people to Pibor where cholera has also broken out. Conflict in early May displaced a further 5,000 individuals to Waat and Walgak, including IDPs re-displaced from Akobo and some returnees.

UPPER NILE – No changes from the last report

► **Background**

Recent conflict is expected to increase the number of displacements in Nassir, where 2,000-4,500 individuals have already been displaced by May clashes. Sector response is awaiting improvements in the security situation.

WARRAB

► **Background**

Following inter-tribal clashes which displaced 1,583 households to Tonj East in February, an additional 695 households of IDPs were displaced to Tonj South by conflict in April. Conflict in Tonj North in mid-May displaced a further 66 households. IOM is due to dispatch NFI kits next week for distribution by WVS in Tonj North and South, while NFI requirements in Tonj East are still being determined.
